After a long battle with cancer, Betty Lillius Wyatt Solomon passed away early Friday morning, August 19, 2011. She is preceded in death by her parents, Wade Dean Wyatt and Grace Alice Urmston Wyatt, and her brother, Robert Dean Wyatt. She leaves behind a son, Joe Solomon Jr., a daughter Cynthia Solomon Henderson, and two grandchildren, Laura Henderson Wassermann, and Matthew Carr Henderson. While living in Montgomery, she was a active member of Court Street Baptist Church and later Heritage Baptist Church. She is currently a member of Lakeview Baptist Church in Oxford, AL. Her education includes graduating from Sidney Lanier High School '52, Birmingham school of Nursing '55, and Samford University '82. She also completed the course of study to become a Parish Nurse in 2002. During her nursing career she achieved numerous certifications in the critical care area including BCLS, ACLS, and PALS and worked in areas including ICU and PACU. Never one to sit idle, she continued her nursing skills even in retirement by serving as a Parish Nurse/Health Ministry Nurse in her church by caring for the homebound, working with the Baptist Service Center, and taking blood pressures every Sunday morning. Her greatest love of memories and photos allowed her to create the history of reminiscence of her family, church activities, and college reunions. Graveside services will be held at Oakwood Annex Cemetery at 3pm Sunday, August 21, 2011 with Rev. Lemuel Burrell officiating.
