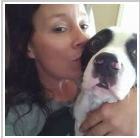

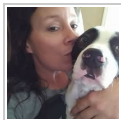

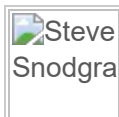

I knew Bobby was Retired Army, but he never told me he was also an Infantryman until recently. The job number for this is supposed to be called "11 Bravo", but most old soldiers call it "11 Bush", because that's where you spend a lot of time. He also told me that he had been a Drill Instructor at the Military Police School, which is one of the toughest jobs in the peacetime service (DI). You see scenes in a lot of old movies where new GIs are getting roused out of bed at 4am or 5am-tough-but the DI has already been up for an hour or more to get ready to come rouse them. Then they run along side them all day, tuck them into their barracks that night, go do some paperwork, and then go home. A seriously tough job on all concerned, especially his (or her) family. From my spot at Lowe's I got to watch him work more than most folks would, and he always did, stocking, moving displays, answering questions by associates and customers. It's easy to picture him as a DI that I would have liked to have had training me. Respect for him wasn't demanded, it was earned.
