Chad A. Allinder, of Pell City, passed away on June 5, 2022. A private family burial will take place in the days to come. A Celebration of Life will be held at a later date.

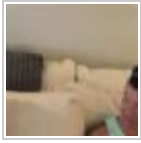

In lieu of flowers, donations can be made to Pell City Animal Control Center and UAB Palliative and Comfort Care Unit.

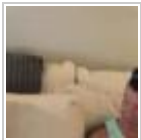
