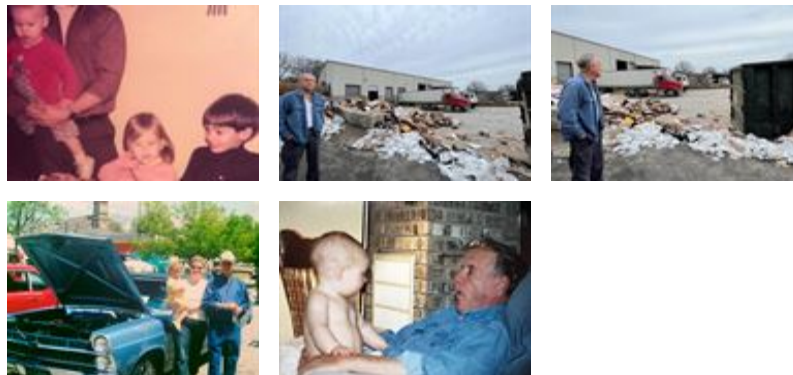

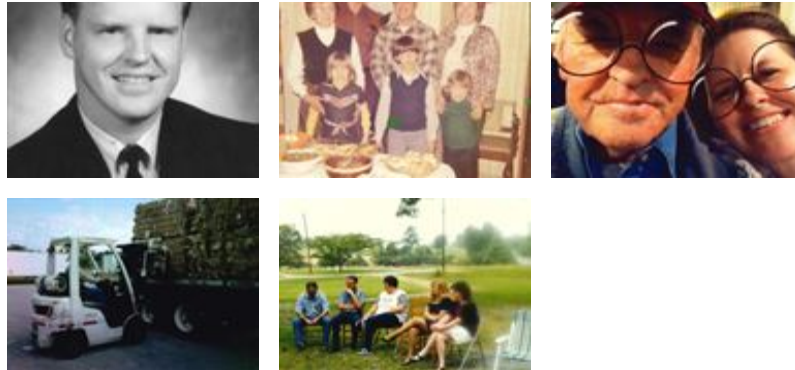
“ Wayne was, without doubt, one of the very best guy friends I have ever known!
