Mr. Dan C. Henderson passed away August 19, 2014, at the age of 89 at his home. Services will be held at Lakeview Baptist Church in Oxford at 11:00 AM on August 22, 2014, with Rev. Mr. Henderson was well known throughout Calhoun County for his contributions to the Calhoun County School System. Assistant Superintendent over Personnel Services and for seven and a half years served as Superintendent's Office as Director of the Calhoun County School System. After his retirement they visited forty-nine states, most of Canada, some of Mexico and the Bahamas and Long East Caribbean cruises. He always gave God credit for any and all of his achievements and for giving him the Best Wife and family he could ask for.
