Services for Doris Allison Ford, 94, of Oxford will be held Thursday, September 28 at 2:00 pm in the Toby Miller Chapel of Miller Funeral Home with Dr. Steven Anthony officiating. She was a faithful member of Hillcrest Baptist Church for many years, and was part of the Fidelis Sunday School Class. In later years she also attended Faith Baptist Church in Coldwater. Before the pandemic, she and her husband were part of a group that visited local skilled care and assisted care facilities each week to sing hymns for residents and volunteered at the Oxford Senior Center. She was the first person to wear the crown of Ms. Senior Calhoun County in 1990 and represented the area in the

State Ms. Senior Pageant that year. She then assisted with the pageant for several years. She served on the Oxford Arts Council for many years as well as RSVP. 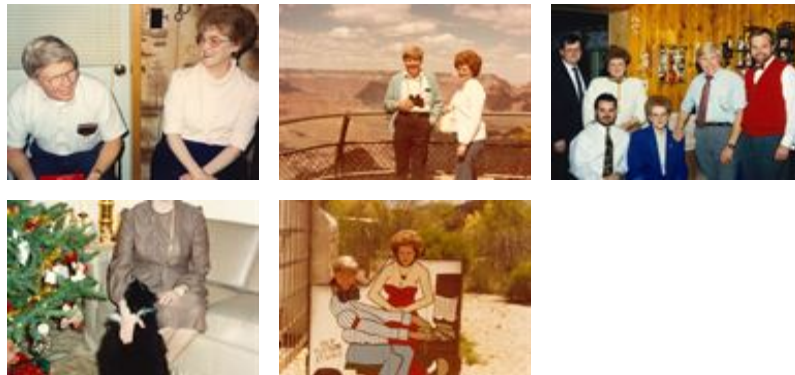
