



Mrs. Dorsie Lee Dryden Lindsey

January 1, 1925 - March 26, 2022

A memorial service for Dorsie Lee Dryden Lindsey, 97, of Oxford, who passed away March 26, 2022 will be held on Saturday, April 9 at 11a.m. at the First United Methodist Church in Oxford. The Rev. Yohan Hong will officiate. Her family will receive friends beginning at 10a.m. at the church.

Mrs. Lindsey was born January 1, 1925 in Cleburne County, AL. She will be remembered by all her family and friends as a loving wife, mother, grandmother, and great-grandmother who was wholly dedicated to her family. She was a talented seamstress and made clothes, not only for her family, but for other people who sought out her talents. This was in addition to all the duties of being the excellent homemaker she was. Later, she gave up the sewing for the public and pursued outside employment. She worked for 16 years at Sperry and Hutchinson until it closed in 1981, and then she worked another 12 1/2 years at Downing's General Store in Anniston. She was actively involved with Meals on Wheels for 15 years with her husband, Wallace Lindsey and was a member of the First United Methodist Church of Oxford since moving to Oxford in the early 1950's.

She is preceded in death by her husband, Wallace Lindsey; parents, John and Sarah Dryden; daughter, Sharon Dempsey; son-in-law Wayne Dempsey; brothers, Curtis Dryden, Howard Dryden, Chester Dryden, John Dryden, Jr., and Hugh Dryden; and sisters, Geraldine Crosson and Irene Gore.

Survivors include children Everett Lindsey (Jan), Linda Boody (Robert), and Larry Lindsey (Paula); six grandchildren, eleven great-grandchildren and several nieces and nephews.
