Edmond Weaver Landers (94) passed away at his home in Oxford, AL on December 24, 2022. Edmond was born April 7, 1928, in Anniston, AL. He is preceded in death by his wife Carolyn Cleveland Landers, his parents James E. and Effie Landers, and brothers Donald and Ned.

He is survived by five children Michael Landers of Lafayette, Colorado, Rhetta (Bill) Haynes of Somerset, KY, Rhonda (Will) Hurley of Ponte Vedra Beach, FL, Eddy Landers, and Steven Landers both of Anniston.

As a businessman he owned and was President of Anniston Motor Express and later built and owned Bama Warehouses, Inc. Edmond loved the city of Oxford, and he served on the Oxford City Council from 1972-76 and 1980-84. He also served on the board of directors of Central Bank of Oxford for 19

years. He was a member of the First Baptist Church of Oxford.

He loved sports and especially baseball. He enjoyed coaching and he coached in the Mustang, Bronco, and Babe Ruth leagues in the 70s and 80s.

Funeral services will be at 2:00 on Friday, December 30th, in the chapel of Miller Funeral Home in Oxford. Visitation will precede the service starting at 12:00 in the chapel. Rev. Stan Albright will officiate.
