September 12, 1944 - May 20, 2025

It is with a heavy heart that the family of Harry Michael “Mike” Marshall (also known to friends as “Horse”) announces his passing on May 20, 2025, at Druid City Hospital in Tuscaloosa, Alabama at the age of eighty.

He was born on September 12, 1944, in Ashland, Kentucky, the son of Marie Bates Marshall and Raymond Leo Marshall. He began working for Armco Steel as a rigger in 1963 and was put in charge of their paint department about 10 years later. He retired in 1996.
