Retired MSGT James H.E. Goss was tired and went to rest with his Lord and Savior on April 23, 2017.

Eugene was born on November 1, 1935 in Rome, GA, to Wess and Minnie B. Goss. He joined the United States Air Force in 1954 and married Juanita Clevenger in 1955. His first assignment was Robins Air Force Base in Warner Robins, GA. During his 20 years of service, he was stationed from one end of the map, Eielson AFB in Fairbanks, Alaska to the other end of the map at Homestead AFB in Florida. He served in the Vietnam War and on numerous other missions all over the world before retiring in 1974.

After his military retirement, he was employed with the Anniston Post Office for 20 years. After his retirement from the post office, he was a fulltime caregiver for his wife, Juanita C. Goss, and an active member of Saints John Masonic Lodge #931 in Anniston.

He is survived by his wife of 62 years, Juanita C. Goss; daughter, Rhonda Parks and her husband, Jim Parks; son, Jimmy Goss and his wife, Machel Goss; grandchildren, Lindsey Lee, Christy Williams, Brittany Price; great grandchildren, Crimson Bryant, Tatum Roberts, Waylon Price, Carly Williams and Grayson Williams, and several nieces and nephews.

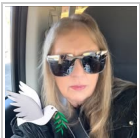
