Our precious mother and Nana, Jan Broadway King, aged 77, passed away on February 7, 2025, at Mobile Infirmary Hospital. There will be a visitation held in the Toby Miller Chapel at Miller Funeral Home from 10:00-12:00 CST, with a service to follow at 12:00 on Saturday, February 15, 2025.

She was an aide at Golden Springs Elementary and later was a successful realtor for more than twenty years.

Jan’s talents included sewing and smocking, and she made many matching

outfits for her children. Her greatest joy was watching her grandchildren's sporting and extracurricular activities. She loved sports and was a diehard Auburn fan.

Jan moved from Oxford to Crowne Healthcare in Mobile in the Spring of 2024. Her days were spent with her friends, playing bingo, attending gospel singing and late night card games. She was known to slip out for occasional Dollar General runs. Her sewing skills were used to make clothing protectors for the residents of the facility. Her family is thankful for the love and care provided to Ms. Jan over the last few months.

Jan was a true fighter in every sense of the word. In 2020, she was on a ventilator for 33 days. Although she had a decline in her health the past few years, she never lost her grace and sweet spirit.
