Jeffery Woodrow Brickhouse, age 60, entered the presence of God on Friday, May 9, 2025, from heart failure at UAB St. Vincent's in Pell City, Alabama. He was born in Brunswick, Georgia, on November 17, 1964. He graduated from Lincoln High School in 1983 and Jacksonville State University in 1987. Jeff had a rich 40+ year ministry as a worship pastor and servant leader in local churches throughout Alabama. He was a proud co-founder of Seminars4Worship, a training ground for worship pastors during his time serving at Integrity Music. He spent his life seeking the presence of God and his family rejoices that he is singing at the throne with every tribe, every tongue, every people. Known as G-Dad, one of his greatest joys was quality time with his children and grandchildren.
