Jennifer was a joy to be around. She was funny, charismatic, & would help anyone any way she could (even when she could barely take care of herself). I know that sometimes people bring problems on themselves by the choices they make in life, but I also know that Jennifer was given far more than her fair share of just plain "bad luck"!!! There's not too many people that could go through in a lifetime what Jennifer went through sometimes on a daily basis, without having some type of mental breakdown. She was a fighter, a hard worker, & one of the best friends you could ever have.
