Jesse 'Jay' Edgar Peoples, Jr., 63 of White Plains, AL went home to be with his Savior on October 14, 2021.

He was preceded in death by his parents Jesse and Louise Peoples, a brother Wayne Peoples, and grandson Isaiah Sheppard.

Jay was also an ordained minister in the Baptist faith and was a member of Son Rise Baptist Church in Oxford, AL.

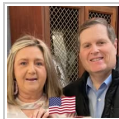
