LaDon Herring was born on August 29, 1945, in Marietta, Georgia. LaDon joined the Army in 1962 and did two tours in Vietnam 1963 and 1967. He passed away on February 11, 2025 due to cancer caused by exposure to Agent Orange or PTSD during his service. On December 23, 1964 he married Claudette Moore, and they went on to have one son, David Herring. After leaving the Army in 1983 at the rank of Master Sergeant, LaDon worked for the U.S. government as a Civilian Service for 20 years. He was incredibly proud of his service to his country. He enjoyed traveling whenever he could with trips to all over the United States. There was always room for fishing with friends and his wife. He had a wonderful sense of humor and was passionate and devoted to his wife of 58 years. He will be laid to rest next to his wife and son at Salt Creek Cemetery in Munford, Alabama.

He is survived by his niece, Cynthia Keller (Kenny).

He is preceded in death by his son, David LaDon Herring, September 1990; wife, Claudette Rose Moore Herring, November 2023; brothers, Gerald Baker,
