Mary was a 1973 graduate of Wellborn High School. She spent the last 10 years working at several Dollar General stores across Calhoun County.

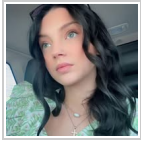
Mary loved being at the beach and on the water. She enjoyed fast cars and big trucks.
