Mr. Michael Anthony Livingston, 63, of Anniston, Alabama, passed away on Friday, December 26, 2025, at home.

Michael graduated from Oxford High School in 1980. After high school he joined the U.S Army in 1984. He was apart of the 4th Infantry Division and 2nd infantry division , DMZ, South Korea. In 1987 he graduated from Ranger School and in 1988 graduated from Special Forces School. After special Forces School he joined the Special Forces Reserve unit as a combat Medic and Sniper. During his reserve years he obtained 2 Bachelor of Science degrees from Auburn University in 1992 and 1993. In the year 2000 he was recalled into service and was part of the 101st Airborne Division and 5th Special Forces Group (Airborne). He did 2 tours of duty in Afghanistan as part of his Special Forces group. In 2002, he did 1 tour of duty as a Delta Force operator in Afghanistan. During that tour he was a personal bodyguard to Afghan President Hamid Karzai's. Michael was a recipient of 2 Bronze Stars and 1 Purple Heart. He was an avid sports fan his whole life, especially his Auburn Tigers. He loved his children and his grandchildren very deeply. He will be truly missed.

Michael is survived by his mother, Alayne Livingston; brother, Matthew Livingston(Shellie);wife, Suzanne; children, Whitney Brown(Dustin), Marley Thrower(Patrick); grandchildren, Bailey, Brody, Jake and Millie; niece, Danielle
