



Mr. Oscar Lavaughn Walden

February 3, 1942 - May 26, 2023

Mr. Oscar Lavaughn Walden, 81 of Ohatchee Alabama passed away on May 26, 2023. He was born on February 3, 1942, raised in Oxford, and graduated from Oxford High School in 1960.

He joined the Navy in 1960 and was sent to Pearl Harbor serving on Tin Cans and USS Johns McCain DL3 then volunteered for the Submarine Service and USS Bashaw SS241. Being discharged after 6 years, he became a member of the Army reserved (315 field artillery), then transferred to the Naval Reserve for the next 32 years, retiring in 1998.

In civilian life he was employed by Alabama Department of Correction as a game warden. Attending night classes, he earned a bachelor's degree from JSU. His class received their diploma from George C. Wallace.

He is preceded in death by his parents, W.O. and Mertice Walden; brother, Carter Donald Walden; sister, Judy Viviette Butler; niece, Diane Butler.

He is survived by his brother, Joseph Earl Walden and his wife Barbara.

Oscar married Connie L. Andrews and has 2 stepchildren, Kim and Scott Andrews; 4 grandchildren, Austin, Ariel, Jesse and Alice.
