Cousin Pam held a very special place with me as an influential nurse in many of my UAB patient- nurse referrals for home care. At first I did not know she had changed from Office Nursing to the home care field. I was glad she did, she was not just good she was GREAT, bringing all the multidisciplines together and keeping them in harmony until we had a well patient. Let me point out Pam’s job was not simple or easy or completed by 5 p.m. I sat on 3 different advisory boards that oversaw Home-Care Nursing and I often reference Pam’s successful techniques. It was as if you were watching a virtuoso achieve full expression and powerful volume at all the right moments. I likened it to Pete Seeger playing his Stella 12-string acoustic guitar ; cue the music “Turn, Turn, Turn”. or maybe more appropriate Led Zeppelin's “Stairway to Heaven“ with Jimmy Page on the 12 string. That was how Pam did her nursing! Near the end of my Dad’s time on earth I placed a call to Pam to set-up Hospice. She was there when we needed her just like thousands of others she orchestrated.

Another characteristic I admired was her steadfastness. Our Holmes Reunion is a perfect example. I cannot recall a reunion that Pam and Sal were not present! She carried the torch for family unity. She showed her happiness to see each and everyone, she would sit and talk, not just to Uncle Orbie’s branch, but to all. She was interested in what you were doing, how you were at that moment, always uplifting and happy in spirit. Easy to laugh with, a pleasure to work beside, and gifted you assurance she would be there next year and in-between too.
