



Mr. Patrick Dean Miller

October 25, 1971 - December 24, 2024

It is with profound sadness and heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Patrick Dean Miller, 53 of Oxford, Alabama. He was a devoted husband, father, soon to be grandfather, beloved son, cherished brother, and dear friend, who left this world after a very short five-week battle with stage four pancreatic cancer on December 24, 2024. Patrick's unexpected passing has left a deep void in the lives of all who knew him, and his memory will be treasured by those who loved him.

Patrick Miller was the president of Miller Funeral Home, Crematory, and Aquamation Center, Miller Florist, Miller Monument Company and Dogwood Trail Memorial Gardens. After graduating high school, he achieved an associates of applied science in mortuary sciences from Jefferson State Community College. While Patrick was studying, he began to open and close graves and install burial vaults for his dad at Miller Funeral Home. In 1992, Patrick started Miller Monument Company and in 1999 Patrick and a partner started Oxford Grave and Vault, where they serviced over 16 funeral homes around Calhoun, Talladega, Etowah and St. Clair counties with their burial vault and grave opening needs. In 2005 Patrick purchased Long Memorials on North Noble St. and in 2015 he sold his shares of Oxford Grave and Vault to his partner. He then purchased the funeral home and florist from his dad and brother in December 2017. Patrick has served on the board of directors for Oxford EMS and also Alabama Law Enforcement Association Foundation

(ALEAF).

Since 2017, Patrick remodeled the funeral home, acquired new vans for the funeral home and flower shop, restored the crematory to top working condition and brought the very first Alkaline Hydrolysis (Aquamation) unit to Alabama. Patrick enjoyed serving his community, traveling, and spending time with his family and fur babies.

Throughout his years he earned the respect and admiration of colleagues and clients alike for his professionalism, work ethic, and dedication. Patrick's career was defined not only by his accomplishments but by his commitment to integrity, excellence, and service. Patrick was a friend to all, a man who valued relationships and was always willing to lend a hand to those in need.

Family was the center of Patrick's life. He was a guiding presence to his wife of almost 30 years, his children, and all of his family and friends, always offering support, wisdom, and love. Patrick's commitment to his family was unwavering, and his legacy will live on through the countless memories he leaves behind. 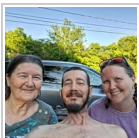
