A memorial service for SGT Robert Eric Fulmer, 30 of Oxford and formerly of Cabot, Arkansas, will be on Thursday, November 19, 2020 at 1:00 pm in the Toby Miller Chapel at Miller Funeral Home. The family will receive friends on the same day from 11:00 am until the time of the service.

Eric passed away on November 14, 2020 in a car accident.
