Rudolph Lee Braden, 95, went home to be with his Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ, on Tuesday, October 17, 2023. A long time resident of Oxford, Alabama, he had recently moved to Hoover. Rudolph grew up in Randolph County, graduated from Wedowee High School, and attended Jacksonville State University. He served as an Army medic in the Korean War, earning him the nickname "Doc." He was a long-time employee of Anniston Army Depot in the Quality Control Division. Rudolph loved to garden and be outdoors; his daughters remember him as someone who loved to tinker and could repair almost anything. Rudolph's faith in Jesus was very important to him, and he loved to share about God's love with everyone he met. He was a member of Coldwater Baptist Church in Oxford and most recently Church on the Bluff in Hoover.

Rudolph was a loving husband and father. He was preceded in death by his wife of 69 years, Ada Jane Braden; daughter, Deborah Braden; parents, Humphrey and Verta Braden; and sisters, Jerusha Braden, Marjorie Baker, and Clara Dobson.
