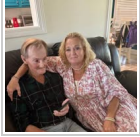

“ Oh, I am saddened to hear that Ms. Sarah has passed. She was a truly beautiful woman, inside and out. I learned of Ms. Sarah from someone down here in South Florida who had gotten an adorable maltipoo pup from her and so my husband, Ray and I had contacted her to get our own maltipoo pup from her in 2010. I had actually flown up to Alabama, rented a car to drive to Ms. Sarah's house, and got my little female maltipoo (Ali) to take back to Boca Raton that late afternoon. She was so gracious to me -- having Ali all ready to go with a pink baby blanket and toys for her. We had Ali for three years until she ran across the street to see my neighbor who had called over and then was hit and killed by a car. Our hearts were torn apart -- this all happened on March 19, 2013, Sarah's birthday. I immediately called her as I wanted to hear her warm, comforting words because our Ali was just so very precious to us and we were having such a hard time with this loss. Sarah and I spoke about once a month. She loved her pets and loved breeding maltipoos and maltese dogs. One day, she called and said she had twin maltese puppies -- a boy and a girl and convinced my husband and I to take both pups, Opie and Bella, in which she had named. Well, Opie and Bella will be 10 years old next month and I had mean to call Sarah on her birthday as it has been way too long since last spoken. I retired from teaching school, we moved about an hour north of our Boca Raton home of 42 years, my dad passed last October, Ray's mom passed the year before, my son got married and now they are expecting in June. I'm just so darn sad I hadn't talked to Sarah before she left this earth. I do know she loved her family and had a lot of faith in the Lord.
