Funeral service for Tommy Hamlin Haynes, 83 of Oxford will be held on Saturday August 29, 2015 at Miller Funeral Home in Oxford with Rev. Roy Cordle and Rev. Scott Whetstone officiating. 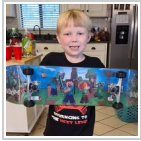

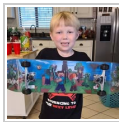
