he never met a stranger. Mac started work at Quick Check in Sylacauga, Alabama in his teens and retired from Winn Dixie Stores, Inc. after over 50 years of service in the Anniston area. After his wife's passing, Mac was eager to get back to work and was hired by former Oxford Mayor Leon Smith to assist part time at the Oxford Senior Citizen Center for which he worked for over 3 years.
