Mr. William 'Bill' Frederick Lipham, age 88, passed away on May 16, 2018.

Bill was born in Albertville, Alabama on November 11, 1929. He lived most of his life in Calhoun County where he graduated from Oxford High School and attended Jacksonville State University. Bill served his country in the US Navy during the Korean Conflict. After his military career, he went on to work at Anniston Army Depot where he retired with more than 30 years of service. After retirement, he did a lot of volunteer work with The Red Cross, Salvation Army and served on the board of The Opportunity Center and The Fellowship House. In his later years, he enjoyed volunteering at Parker Christian Life Center where he did more visiting and doing silly pranks than he did work. He was a member at Parker Memorial Baptist Church for more than 30 years and it held a very special place in his heart as did Bynum Baptist Church where he became a Christian in 1954.

Bill is survived by his wife of 64 years, Evelyn Owen Lipham; daughter, Ashley L. McDuffie (Jeremy); sons, Christopher Lipham and William Brent Lipham; two granddaughters, Shelby Lipham and Alex McDuffie; four grandsons, Joshua Lipham, Jordan Lipham, Matthew Lipham and Hayden McDuffie; one great grandson, Avery Lipham, and a host of extended family members and friends.

He is preceded in death by his parents, Ray and Carrie Lipham and a brother, Richard Lipham.
