



## Yolanda Catalina Vedovato

November 25, 1935 - January 24, 2022

A Mass of Christian Burial for Yolanda Catalina Vedovato, age 86 of Oxford, will be held on

She is preceded in death by Antonio Vedovato, her husband of 35 years, her siblings Mauro

Arturo Palma and Maria Christina Palma, and her firstborn child Yolanda ("Yolandita") Patricia

Vedovato, who passed away at nine months of age in 1960.

She is survived by her brother Mario Rodolfo Palma, her five children: Marco, Carlos, Xiomara,

Victor, Beatriz, son-in-law Timothy Fisher and four grandchildren.

Yolanda enjoyed helping people, traveling, spending time with family, and being an active

member of her church community.

Yolanda was born 1935 in Comayagüela, Honduras to Manuel Antonio and Emma Coralia

Palma. She was married in 1957 to Antonio Vedovato. In 1954 she graduated from Escuela

Normal de Señoritas as a primary school teacher. Then she obtained a scholarship to attend the

Escuela Nacional de Enfermeria to become a Nurse. In 1958 she was in the first cohort of nurses to graduate college in Honduras (previously, a degree was not required for nursing). In 1959 Yolanda immigrated to the United States, where she was naturalized and became a citizen in 1985. She became a homemaker and raised her five children in California before moving to Alabama in 2007.

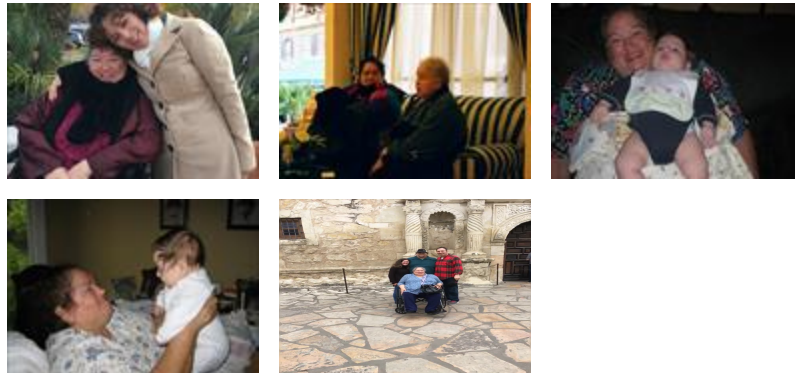

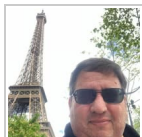
